
Framework Partnership Agreement on Copernicus User Uptake (FPCUP)

- Starting point: Data cannot be exploited by end-users
- Aim: Support public or private service providers to transform space data into accessible and usable information

Coordinated by DLR




50 partners from 23 countries

- 160 actions are running,
 60 actions completed

- building active networks and communities;
- developing and implementing new services and applications based on Copernicus.
